DISCUSSION ITEMS

Parking around Paddock Lane School

Chief Bruce Lang provided an overview of the current parking situation and proposed changes to the parking around Paddock Lane School. Chief Lang, as Traffic Engineer, is going to try the proposed changes for ninety (90) days and see how they impact the traffic flow and parking around Paddock Lane School. The City Council preferred banning parking along the west side of 14th Street between Monroe and Park Street from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. instead of twenty four (24) hours a day.

Review of the City's Budget for 2009-2010

Mayor Schuster provided an overview of the current status of the City's budget. The City is speculating a look to \$120,000.00 shortfall in revenue and if this is true, the Mayor and City Council will need to look for places to cut the budget.

Homestead Act of 2010

Tobias Tempelmeyer provided an overview of the current proposed contract for the homesteading of City owned property. The City Council would like to advertise this program over the next few months.
