WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Beatrice established fees relating to animals and animal ownership; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City council of the City of Beatrice find and determine that it is necessary to adjust such fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEATRICE, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That the fee schedule for animals and animal ownership shall be as follows:

| 1) Destruction of a dog or cat | \$20.00 |
| 2) Appeal the determination of animal to be a potentially dangerous animal, dangerous animal, or pit bull | \$100.00 |
| 3) Request for termination of a determination order declaring an animal to be a potentially dangerous animal or dangerous animal | \$100.00 |
| 4) Annual registration fee for a dangerous animal | \$35.00 |
| 5) Annual registration fee for a potentially dangerous animal or pit bull | \$25.00 |
| 6) Appeal a declaration order declaring an individual to be a reckless owner | \$100.00 |
| 7) Dog or cat licenses are as follows: | |
| Each spayed female or neutered male dog | \$5.00 |
| All other dogs over the age of six (6) months | \$20.00 |
| Each spayed female or neutered male cat | \$3.00 |
| All other cats over the age of six (6) months | \$10.00 |
| 8) Additional fee veterinarians may charge when issuing licenses on behalf of the City | \$1.00 per license |
| 9) Daily boarding fee | \$7.00 |
| 10) Impoundment fees are as follows: | |
| First violation per animal | \$20.00 |

Second violation per animal	\$30.00
Third violation per animal	\$35.00
Fourth and all ensuing violations per animal	\$45.00

11) Voluntary impoundment of dog or cat \$35.00
