

ORDINANCE NUMBER 26-29

An ordinance to amend Section 9-4 of the Beatrice City Code regarding fire prevention and protection; and to repeal conflicting ordinances or parts of ordinances; and to provide for publication in electronic form and for an effective date of this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEATRICE, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-4 of the Beatrice City Code be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 9-4. Registration required.

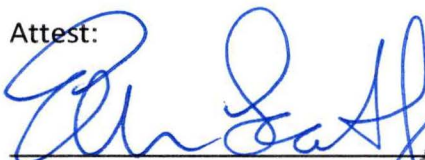
- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to use or operate any alarm system without current valid registration.
- (b) Any person installing a new alarm system shall have thirty (30) calendar days from the date of installation to obtain an alarm registration.
- (c) Any person who is a governmental entity or political unit shall be required to obtain an alarm system registration pursuant to the provisions of this article; however, such governmental entity or political unit is not required to pay the fee required for the registration.
- (d) Alarm systems at single-family residences and duplexes shall be exempt from the registration requirement set forth in this section. "

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

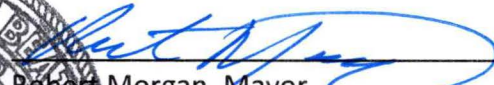
SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in electronic form as provided by law.

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEATRICE, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-4 of the Beatrice City Code be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 9-4. Registration required.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person ~~within the zoning jurisdiction of the city or for any person who has the city fire department as a first responder~~ to use or operate any alarm system without current valid registration ~~thereof, not to include single family residences and duplexes.~~
- (b) Any person ~~within the zoning jurisdiction of the city or any person who has the city fire department as a first responder~~ installing a new alarm system shall have thirty (30) calendar days from the date of installation to obtain an alarm registration ~~therefor as required in this article, not to include single family residences and duplexes.~~
- (c) Any person who is a governmental entity or political unit shall be required to obtain an alarm system registration pursuant to the provisions of this article; however, such governmental entity or political unit is not required to pay the fee required for the registration.
- (d) Alarm systems at single-family residences and duplexes shall be exempt from the registration requirement set forth in this section."
